Helpful Storage Tips:

- Fill containers to capacity: partially full or bulging cartons may tip or collapse. Heavy items like tools should be packed in small boxes so they are easy to lift. Books should be packed flat.
- Mirrors, windows, and screens should be stored on edge not flat.
- Label boxes and take home a list of the labeled boxes for easy reference when you need to locate your goods.
- Furniture: place a pallet, corrugated cardboard mat, or sheet on the floor and stand sofas and mattresses on end. Disassemble beds and tables and wrap legs in paper. If a table will not disassemble, place padding on the floor and place the table on its top with the legs pointing up. Use dresser tops for stacking boxes and dresser drawers for linens or small, delicate items. Keep upholstery off the floor. Most lightweight chairs can be stacked "seat to seat" or placed upside down on tables which cannot be disassembled.
- Appliances: a refrigerator or freezer should be thoroughly dry and stored with its door slightly ajar. Some goods can be stored inside large appliances and boxes can be stacked on tops of stoves, refrigerators, and freezers. Make sure stoves and cooking equipment are cleaned before they are stored.
- Finally – place a light weight cotton dust cover on your favorite.

Prohibited Storage Goods

Common sense and state laws determine what may be stored. You alone control access to your space; therefore, never store live animals, perishables, explosives, flammable liquids, fuels, toxic materials, or other items of this nature. Remember most charcoal has been pretreated with lighter fluid and can spontaneously combust.
